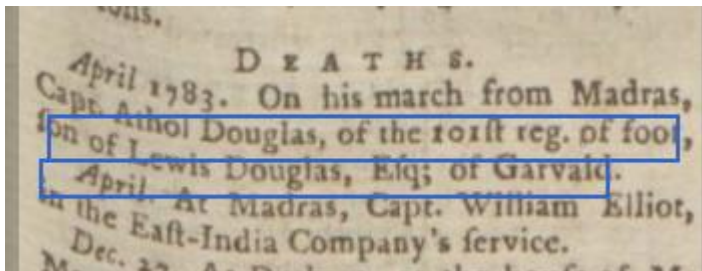

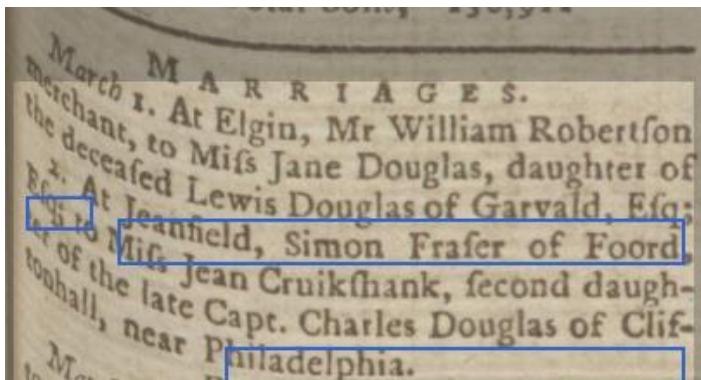

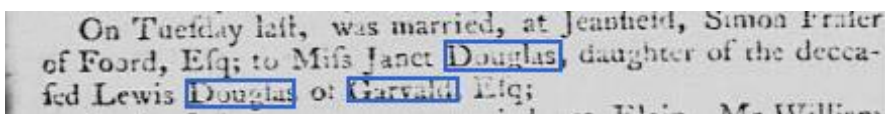

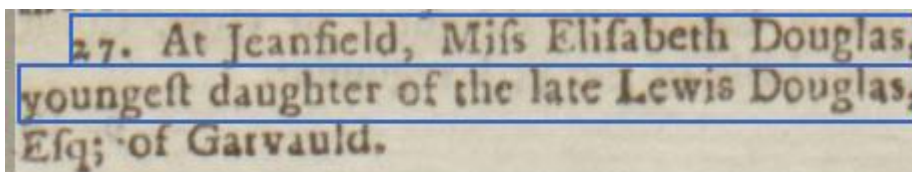

Sir William Douglas, the fifth Baronet, of Glenbervie, a lawyer of great abilities, knowledge, and learning, of a most amiable disposition, of great benevolence, a worthy and most agreeable member of society. In the year 1726 he was chosen Provost of the city of St. Andrew's, and was annually re-elected for nineteen years successively. He was appointed one of the General Inspectors for the customs upon tobacco in Scotland, which office he enjoyed as long as he lived. He married Elizabeth, daughter of John Douglas, of Garvold, Esq. by Elizabeth his wife, daughter of William and Isabel Douglas, so that she was the sixth generation of that name by both father and mother's side. With her he lived forty-six years in perfect happiness and felicity, but dying without issue in July, 1764, the representation devolved upon his brother.

**Another lady who dwelt in Dalkeith — Elizabeth Douglas, Lady Glenbervie—arouses some interest in our minds. Her descent seems to have been somewhat confusing, as she was “daughter of John Douglas of Garvold, Esq., by Elizabeth, his wife, daughter of William and Isabel Douglasses, so that she was the sixth generation of that name by both father and mother's side,” and her life must have been a perfect idyll, her husband (also a Douglas—Sir William of Glenbervie) being “a man of parts, knowledge, and learning, of a most amiable disposition and of great benevolence, a worthy and most agreeable member of society,” and we are told “with her he lived forty-six years in perfect happiness and felicity.” This lady, who inherited lands in Dalkeith from her mother's father, died in 1777, and was buried beside her husband in the Dalkeith Kirkyard. Her relatives continued their hold in Dalkeith, possessing the house of Jeanfield, and Miss Marjory Douglas, daughter of Lewis Douglas of Garvold, died there in 1794. As**
